What is TRiO?

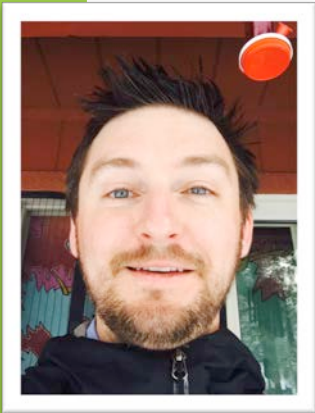

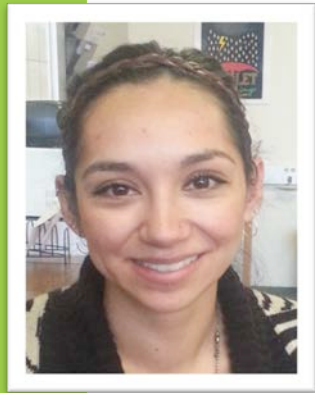


Meet the Staff

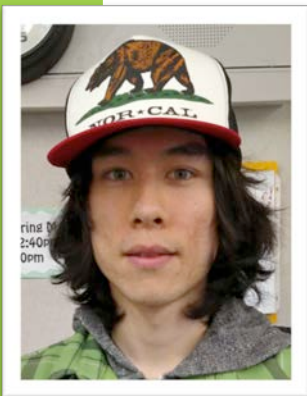
Natalie Cázares Rodriguez- ETS Program Assistant
